NOTES TO THE INTERIM FINANCIAL REPORT

PART (A): EXPLANATORY NOTES PURSUANT TO MFRS 134: INTERIM FINANCIAL REPORTING

1. Basis of Preparation

This interim financial report of Amtel Holdings Berhad ("AMTEL" or "Company") and its subsidiaries ("AMTEL Group" or "the Group") are unaudited and has been prepared in accordance with the reporting requirements as set out in Malaysian Financial Reporting Standards ("MFRS") 134: *Interim Financial Reporting* and Paragraph 9.22 of the Main Market Listing Requirements of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad ("Bursa Securities").

The condensed consolidated interim financial report should be read in conjunction with the latest audited financial statements of AMTEL Group for the financial year ended 30 November 2024 ("FY 2024") and the accompanying explanatory notes attached to this interim financial report. These explanatory notes provide an explanation of events and transactions that are significant to an understanding of the changes in the financial position and performance of the Group since FY 2024.

2. Significant Accounting Policies

The accounting policies and methods of computation adopted by the Group in the preparation of this interim financial report are consistent with those used in the preparation of the Group's audited financial statements for FY 2024.

Our Group has not early adopted any new standards, amendments/improvements to MFRSs which are applicable to the Group that have been issued by the Malaysian Accounting Standards Board but are not yet effective for the Group's current financial period. Nevertheless, the Group and the Company expects that the initial application of the accounting standards, amendments or interpretations are not expected to have significant impact to the current period and prior period financial statements of the Group and the Company.

3. Audit Qualification

The audit report on the Group's financial statements for FY 2024 did not contain any qualification.

The Group's operations are not affected by seasonal or cyclical factors during the financial period under review.

PART (B): ADDITIONAL INFORMATION PURSUANT TO BURSA SECURITIES MAIN MARKET LISTING REQUIREMENTS

1. Review of Performance

Analysis of financial quarter performance

For Q3 FY2025, the Group reported revenue of RM19.33 million and profit after tax of RM2.15 million, marking a notable increase from RM18.17 million and RM1.12 million, respectively, in the prior year's corresponding quarter. The rise in financial performance is primarily attributed to higher sales volume and profitability in the ICT segment.

Analysis of the 9-month financial performance

The Group's nine-month results recorded revenue of RM52.17 million, a 5.5% drop compared to RM55.22 million in the corresponding period of the preceding financial year. The decrease was mainly due to the lower sales recorded by both the ICT and TIS segments in the preceding financial quarter (Q2 FY2025).

Despite the lower revenue, our Group delivered stronger results during the current financial period with a profit after tax of RM4.61 million as compared to RM4.19 million in the corresponding period of last year, largely attributable to higher contributions from the ICT segment.

For Q3 FY 2025, the ICT business remained the core contributor to the Group's revenue, accounting for approximately 83.6% (Q3 FY 2024: 80.4%) of AMTEL Group's revenue and was also the main contributor to the Group's profit after tax.

The ICT segment registered both sales growth and improved margins this quarter, posting RM16.48 million in revenue and RM1.79 million in profit after tax, up from RM15.26 million and RM1.10 million, respectively, in the same quarter last year.

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1. Review of Performance (Cont'd)

ICT Segment (Cont'd)

On a period-over-period basis, although the lower sales in Q2 FY2025 impacted the ninemonth revenue, the ICT segment still delivered an overall increase in profitability, largely driven by stronger performance and healthier margins achieved in Q1 and Q3 of FY2025.

On a quarter-to-quarter basis, despite a slight decline in revenue, the segment achieved higher profit after tax, primarily driven by improved operational efficiency and enhanced margins.

On the other hand, the overall lower performance of the TIS segment during the current financial period was mainly due to reduced revenue and margins from smaller-scale civil infrastructure projects

The Group delivered stronger results this financial quarter, posting RM19.33 million in revenue and RM2.15 million in profit after tax, up from RM15.53 million and RM0.89 million in the immediate preceding quarter. Stronger sales and increased profitability in the ICT segment mainly drove the improved performance.

3. Commentary on the Group's Prospects

The Group remains agile in navigating global economic uncertainties and tariff-related challenges with prudent capital management and strategic measures to mitigate its potential impact on our operations and financial performance.

While we continue to expand our ICT business, we are also strategically channeling resources and manpower, accelerating the development and commercialisation of our new business ventures in vehicle manufacturing and assembly. These initiatives aim to diversify revenue streams and enhance the Group's overall financial performance.

Henceforth, we remain optimistic about the Group's performance for the remaining quarter of the financial year.

The LTIP shall be in force for a period of five (5) years until 2 October 2027.
